## Table Dressing

Table dressings are a key element of any dining room. They can be as simple as a white tablecloth or as elaborate as a multi-layered tablecloth with a matching runner and placemats. The key is to choose a color and pattern that complements the rest of the room.

When choosing a tablecloth, consider the color and pattern. A solid color is always a safe choice, but a patterned tablecloth can add interest to the room. If you choose a patterned tablecloth, make sure the pattern is not too busy. A subtle pattern is often the best choice. The color of the tablecloth should also complement the other colors in the room. For example, if you have a room with a lot of red, a white tablecloth would be a good choice.

## Weathering the elements

When it comes to tablecloths, there are a few things to keep in mind. First, choose a material that is easy to clean and maintain. A white tablecloth is a classic choice, but it can be difficult to keep white looking white. A light-colored patterned tablecloth might be a better choice. Second, choose a tablecloth that is the right size for your table. A tablecloth that is too small will look awkward, and a tablecloth that is too large will be a hassle to manage. Finally, choose a tablecloth that is the right color for your room. A tablecloth that is too bright or too dark can make the room look out of balance.
