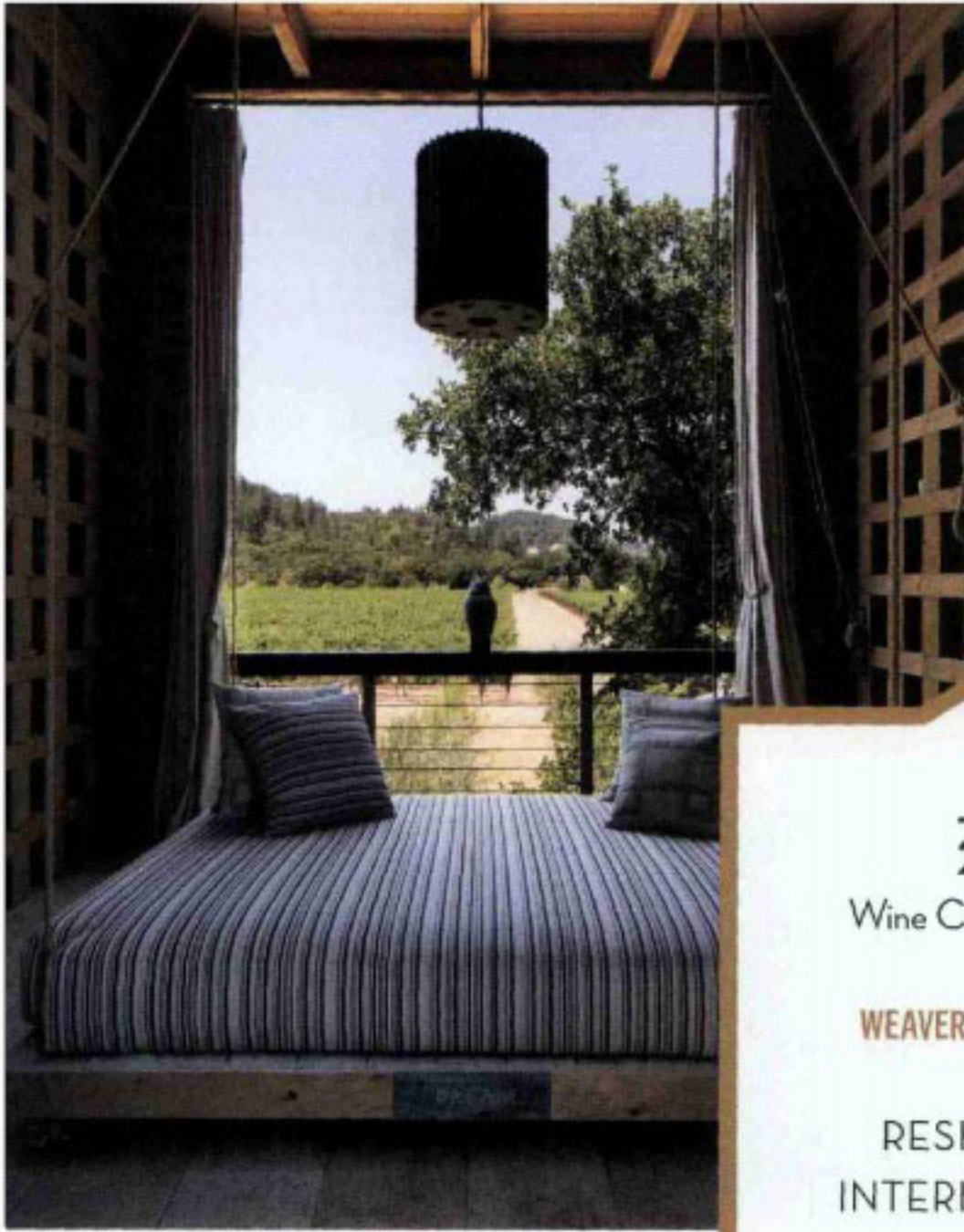

WHEN DESIGNING A RELAXING RETREAT IN St. Helena for a busy bicoastal couple, the Weaver Design Group was elated to create a dreamy escape. What started as a small cottage that was modernized over time has grown into a 3,000-square-foot home with an open floor plan and scenic views of surrounding vineyards. "The clients are from the East Coast and fell in love with St. Helena," says Amy Weaver, founder of Weaver Design Group.

Weaver and her team combined a mix of interesting materials with custom furniture and lighting to create a rustic wine country ambiance but with a modern edge. In the living room, the foundation of color is set in an expansive almond-colored rug by Architectural Design Carpet, then complemented with a robin's-egg blue sofa covered in fabric from Hewn. A pair of Ochre side chairs sit next to an industrial-like fireplace that spans the entire wall. Bright blue barstools covered in Holly Hunt leather pull the eye toward the rustic kitchen.

Outside, Weaver and her team created cozy lounging and dining areas, where the couple often spends time entertaining, with furniture by JANUS et Cie topped with Perennials Fabrics. One of the most interesting spaces is the hideaway bedroom which features a swinging bed surrounded by layers of wood. "The project was really fun because of the interesting use of space," says Weaver of the finished design. —Lindsey Shook
